Bell Times

Our bell times are the same as last year. Our entry bell will ring at 8:30 and again at 8:35 to signify classes have started, students can begin arriving when our supervision starts at 8:15. Our end of day bell has also remained the same and will ring at 2:35.

Enrollment and Class Lists

We continue to experience growth within our area and this has had an impact on our class lists. As such, class lists have not been finalized as we continue to place new registrants. I am sharing this news with you as this may create a situation where we need to move students around to balance classes or add an additional class. These decisions typically happen during the month of September if enrollment pressures dictate the need to do so. If that happens, we will communicate with impacted families as soon as possible. Teachers will be reaching out to you by email to introduce themselves and welcome you and your child to BLT Jr prior to curriculum night.

Curriculum Night

On September 3rd both the JR and SR Buildings are having their annual curriculum night. Curriculum night is an opportunity to meet your child's teacher for the year and get information about what they will be learning. This year we will be taking a collaborative approach with the senior building. Both schools will be open from 6:00-7:00pm and families can visit both at their own pace. At 7:00, we will all meet at the playgrounds for a cold treat prior to everyone leaving to get ready for the first day of school the next morning. We encourage you to bring your child's school supplies with you on Curriculum night so there will be less to carry on the first day.
